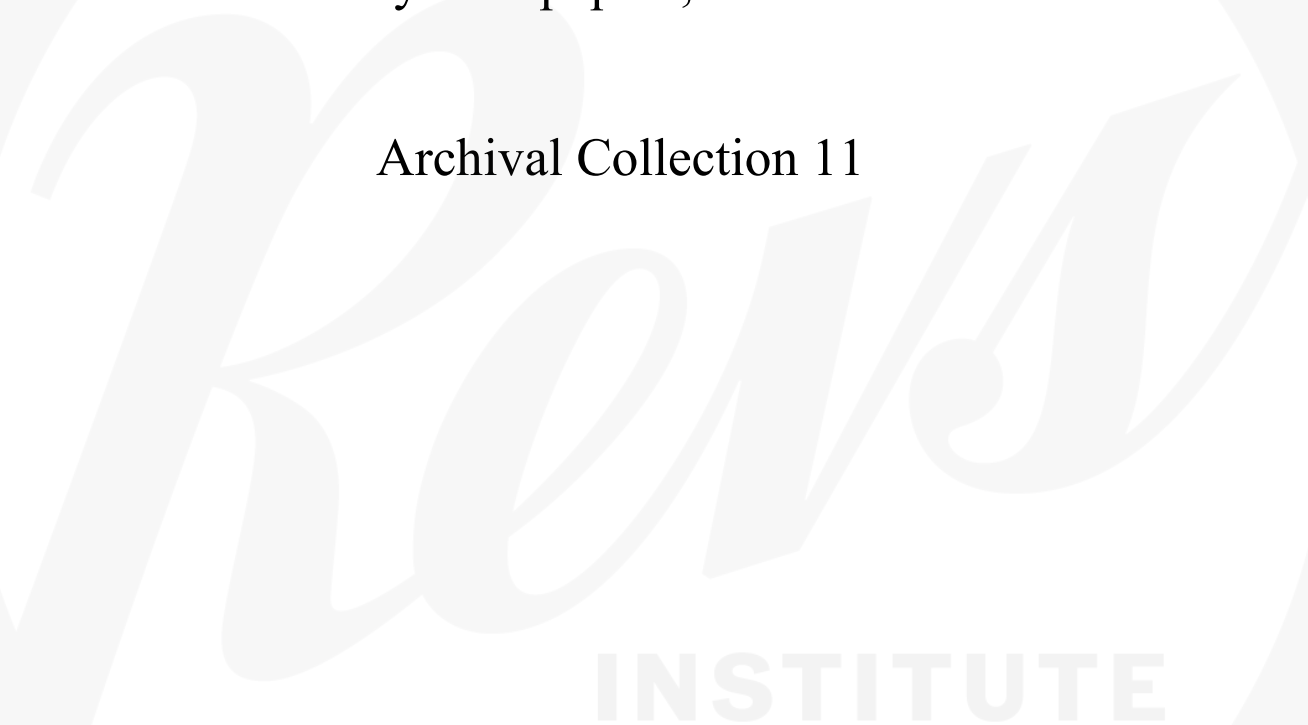

**Abstract:** The collection contains articles, newspaper clippings, and programs about international automobile races and tracks/venues from publications including *The Autocar*, *The Motor*, and *Motor Sport*. It also includes original race reports written by Barre Lyndon, as well as original programs from some races and events. The collection also contains articles, news clippings, and reports concerning the exhibits at international automobile shows from 1923 through 1935; deaths of drivers, racing clubs, racing year retrospectives, automobile engineering and mechanics, innovations, and other automobile-related information.

**Language:** Materials are in English.

**Biography:** Barré Lyndon (August 12, 1896 – October 23, 1972) is a pseudonym for Alfred Edgar Frederick Higgs, a British author and journalist for *The Autocar*, *The Motor*, and *Motor Sport* during the 1920s and 1930s. He was a motor sports journalist who wrote novels for young adults, often with automotive and racing themes, and he also had a career as a playwright and screenwriter in London and Hollywood. His automobile racing books include *Combat: A Motor Racing History* (London: Windmill Press, 1933), *Circuit Dust* (London: John Miles, LTD, 1934), and *Grand Prix* (London: John Miles, LTD, 1935).

**Scope and Content Note:** The collection contains articles, newspaper clippings, some photographs, and programs about international automobile races and tracks/venues from publications including *The Autocar*, *The Motor*, and *Motor Sport*. It also includes original race reports written by Barre Lyndon, as well as original programs from some races and events. The collection is divided into four series.

**Series I (Races and Tracks)** contains articles, newspaper clippings, maps, and a few photographs about international automobile races and tracks/venues from publications including *The Autocar*, *The Motor*, and *Motor Sport*. The series also includes original race reports written by Lyndon, as well as original programs from some races and events. The series is organized by general location: Africa and the Middle East, the Americas, Asia, Australia and New Zealand, and Europe.

**Series 2 (Automobile Shows)** contains articles and reports, mostly from *The Autocar*, *The Car*, *The Motor*, and *Motor Sport*, describing the exhibits at international automobile shows from 1923 through 1935.

**Series 3 (Drivers)** contains clippings relating to specific drivers, including information about crashes and deaths.

**Series 4 (Miscellaneous)** contains miscellaneous clippings and articles about racing clubs, racing year retrospectives, automobile engineering and mechanics, innovations, and other automobile-related information.

**Acquisition Note:** The Miles Collier Collections acquired the Barré Lyndon papers in 2011 (accession 2011-043).
