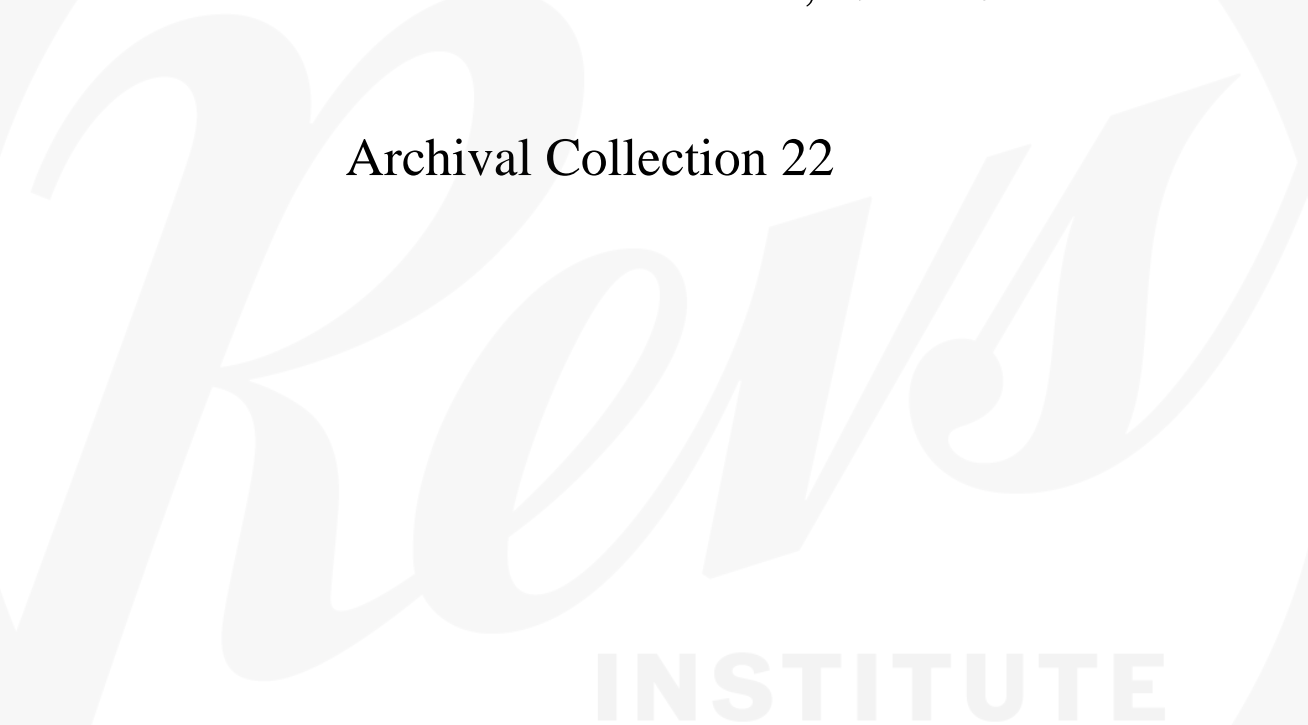

Abstract: The Carrera Panamericana collection, 1928-1971 contains maps, instructions, programs, rosters, and rules for the drivers of the Carrera Panamericana races, as well as press releases, publicity and news clippings of the event. The collection includes prints taken by several photographers, especially Edward Eves, documenting the cars at the start, at various stages, and several in crashes; close-ups of drivers; officials at the awarding of prizes and press conferences. House and Senate reports concern the development of the highway connecting the U.S. to the Panama Canal for defense purposes.

Language: Materials are in English and Spanish.
