Abstract: The Chris Economaki photographs, 1991-2002 consist of 6,021 total images. This includes 150 photographic prints, 5,258 black-and-white negatives, and 613 color negatives. Events of note are the Montreal Grand Prix, Detroit Grand Prix, CART events, and various NASCAR races. Economaki took photographs at various venues and cities, such as Lime Rock, Atlanta, Daytona, Nashville, and Talladega. The Chris Economaki photographs are not available on the Revs Digital Library at this time.

Language: Materials are in English

Biography: Chris Economaki was born in Brooklyn, New York on October 15, 1920. He saw his first race at age 9 at the board track in Atlantic City. At age 13, he began his racing journalism career by selling copies of *National Auto Racing News*. The next year he wrote his first column for the magazine, and by 1950 he became the editor for *National Speed Sport News*. He eventually became the owner, publisher, and editor of the *National Speed Sport News* writing a column called "The Editor's Notebook" for over fifty years. Economaki was also known as a track announcer at a number of major races in the 1940s and 1950s, introducing millions of Americans to auto racing as an expert television commentator. In the 1960s, he contributed "Sport of Speed" segments to NBC Radio and then switched to CBS Sports after 23 years. He received numerous major awards, was inducted into many motorsports halls of fame, and had an award named after him: the Economaki Champion of Champions Award.
