Abstract: The Harold Javetz photographs, 1959-1968 consist of 101 color transparencies and 17 black-and-white photographic prints. Included are images of races such as Daytona 3 Hours Continental race, 12 Hours of Sebring, and Nassau Speed Week. Notable venues in this collection include Daytona International Speedway, Sebring International Raceway, and Oakes Field.

Biography: Harold Javetz was born on May 17, 1936 in Savannah, Georgia and died on January 6, 2013. He served in the Air Force Reserve and was the president of the Atlantic Meat Company in Savannah until his retirement in 2001. From 1993 to 2008 he was the owner of Coffee Bluff Marina. As a race car driver and an avid car collector, Javetz was also a member of the Ferrari Club of America during the 1970s. During his time as a member of the club, he would enter races at Roebling Road in Bloomingdale, Georgia.

Scope and Content Note:

The Harold Javetz photographs are organized into two series separated by format:

Series 1: Contains 101 color transparencies (1 clamshell binder box). Included are images of races such as 12 Hours of Sebring and Nassau Speed Week.

Series 2: Contains 17 black-and-white photographic prints (1 clamshell binder box). Included are images of Daytona 3 Hours Continental race in 1962.
