**Abstract:** The Marcus Chambers photographs, 1988-1996 consist of 280 color transparencies. Images of events include London-Sydney Rally, Alpine Rally, 12 Hours of Sebring, Acropolis Rally, and Liège-Rome-Liège Rally. Venues photographed include Sebring International Raceway, Circuit de la Sarthe, and Ancien Palais des Expositions. People of note are Pat Moss and Ann Wisdom. Images of various marques include Austin-Healey, MG, Hillman, Austin, Morris, and Alfa Romeo. Also included are various correspondences, directories, brochures, and images from automobile museums in France. The Marcus Chambers transparencies were digitized and are available on the Revs Digital Library (http://stanford.io/2eNngT9).

Language: Materials are in English and French.

**Biography:** Marcus Mordaunt Bertram Chambers was born on August 8, 1910. The son of a naval captain, he spent much of his early life abroad. His family was involved in the 1917 explosion in Halifax, Nova Scotia when a French munitions ship collided with a Swedish vessel, killing 2,000 people and destroying half the city, but his family home survived. After World War I, his family moved to Britain where Chambers' father taught him to drive. He gravitated to the motor trade when he became a "shop boy" for a garage in London. A year later he opened his own garage, veering toward vintage Bentleys, which he tuned and used in trials held by the Vintage Sports Car Club. He became linked with the HRG sports cars, and drove in the 24 Hours of Le Mans in 1937, 1938, and 1939. He served in the Navy during World War II, afterward becoming the HRG team manager in 1948, and later became the manager of British Motor Company in 1958. Chambers also wrote many books while living in Oxfordshire, England including *Seven Year Twitch* (1962), *Works Wonders* (1995) and his autobiography, *With a Little Bit of Luck!* (1998). Chambers died August 5, 2009.

**Transfer Note:** The Marcus Chambers photographs, 1988-1996 were transferred from the Karl E. Ludvigsen papers, circa 1905-2011. Original order and provenance within the Karl E. Ludvigsen papers, circa 1905-2011 were largely lost.
