**Abstract:** The Ken Breslauer papers contain scrapbooks containing newspaper articles, race results, photographs, racing programs, and entry lists, documenting racing events from 1950-1995, especially at the Sebring International Raceway. The papers also include road film, maps, and scrapbooks collected by Mr. Breslauer from persons who took trips to Florida from the late 1920s through the early 1960s. The scrapbooks contain personal notes, photographs, memorabilia, and postcards.

**Language:** Materials are in English.

**Biography:** Kenneth C. Breslauer is an auto racing historian and as of August 2016 is communications director and track historian at Sebring International Raceway. He graduated from the University of West Florida with a degree in journalism and was a sports writer before joining Sebring in 1985. He founded his own magazine in 1981 called *Auto Racing Memories*, and served as editor and publisher of the *International Motor Sports Association Yearbook* from 1989 to 1995. Breslauer also authored the book, *Roadside Paradise: the Golden Age of Florida's Tourist Attractions 1929-71*.

**Scope and Content Note:** The Ken Breslauer papers are organized into two series:

**Series 1 (Racing):** Consists of 40 scrapbooks featuring racing events at the Sebring International Raceway from 1950 to 1995. In addition, the collection holds two scrapbooks of Daytona 24 Hours from 1962 to 1995, Palm Beach Shores 1950-1951, Vero Beach 1952, and MacDill AFB 1953-1954. The scrapbooks contain newspaper articles, race results, photographs, racing programs, and entry lists.

The collection also includes news clippings, lap charts, media guides, regulation and entry forms, and ephemera from the Sebring races. Photographs of the ephemera are available on [RevsCat](https://revscat.andornot.com/Record/revs117888) (<https://revscat.andornot.com/Record/revs117888>).

The collection includes prints of Breslauer's photographs of venues, vehicles, and drivers at the races. As of August 2016, the prints are not available on the Revs Digital Library.

**Series 2 (Travels to Florida):** Consists of scrapbooks and 8mm film collected by Mr. Breslauer from persons who took trips to Florida from the late 1920s through the early

1960s. The scrapbooks contain personal notes, photographs, memorabilia, and postcards. Also includes road maps from 1930s through the mid-1960s.

**Acquisition Note:** The Miles C. Collier Collection acquired the Kenneth C. Breslauer papers in 2011 and 2013 (accessions 2011-054, 2011-058, and 2013-008).

**Access Restrictions:** The Kenneth C. Breslauer papers are open for research.
