Abstract: The Smith Hempstone Oliver photographs, 1930-1959 consist of 1,204 black-and-white negatives. Also included are photographic prints, documentation, ephemera, books, correspondence, and other items. Images of racing events include 24 Hours of Le Mans at the Circuit de la Sarthe, the Indianapolis 500 at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, and the French Grand Prix at Reims-Gueux. Of note are images through his association with the racing teams of Briggs Cunningham. The Smith Hempstone Oliver negatives are digitized and are available on the Revs Digital Library at (http://stanford.io/2qsH4iS).

Language: Materials are in English.

Biography: In the early 1930s, Smith Hempstone Oliver joined the United States Navy. Stationed at the Naval Yard in Brooklyn, New York, he regularly scoured the streets looking for old and interesting cars to photograph. Oliver became a collector, and antique automobile photographer who was later appointed the Curator of Transportation at the Smithsonian Institute, in Washington D.C., from 1946-1956. Oliver is known for writing the *Catalog of the Cycle Collection of the Division of Engineering, United States National Museum*, a book on the Smithsonian Cycle collection, in 1953. He also co-authored *Wheels and Wheeling: The Smithsonian Cycle Collection* with Donald H. Berkebile in 1974, along with writing other books on automobiles, motorcycles, and steam locomotives.

Scope and Content Note: The Smith Hempstone Oliver photographs, 1930-1959 consists of negatives, photographic prints, documentation, ephemera, books, correspondence, and other items.

The Smith Hempstone Oliver photographs, 1930-1959 is organized into three series according to format:

Series 1 (**Documentation and Ephemera**): Includes various documents such as personal correspondence, Oliver's travel diary from June 9-July 23, 1950, registration certificates, engine drawings, and catalogs. Also included are pins from Watkins Glen Grand Prix Festival, the George Vanderbilt Cup Race, and *Ettore Bugatti: A Biography*, written by W.F. Bradley.

Series 2 (Photographic Prints): Includes images from various events such as the Indianapolis 500 1946, French Grand Prix 1950, Le Mans 1950, Vanderbilt Cup Races 1936-1937, and the World Fair ARCA Race 1940. Images of marques such as Stutz and Welch-Winton Bullet No. 2 are also included.

Series 3 (Negatives): Images of racing events include the 24 Hours of Le Mans at the Circuit de la Sarthe, the Indianapolis 500 at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, and the French Grand

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Prix at Reims-Gueux. Of note are images through his association with the racing teams of Briggs Cunningham. The Smith Hempstone Oliver negatives are digitized and are available on the Revs Digital Library at (http://stanford.io/2qsH4iS).
